ZOOM UNDER 16 TRAVEL PASS

Travel South Yorkshire's Zoom Under 16 Travel Pass is available to help young people in South Yorkshire get from A to B for £1. Zoomers can travel anytime, anywhere in South Yorkshire on buses or trams for a single fare per journey. They can also buy discounted 1, 7 or 28 day tickets, which are loaded straight onto the pass, which might be cheaper if they travel regularly. The pass proves your child is eligible to travel for the concessionary fares on public transport in South Yorkshire.
