Milk for September



If you would like your child to receive milk at school from September, this can be purchased via the School Shop on Arbor. **Please complete this transaction by Friday 17th July.**

The cost for the Autumn Term is £18.00.

If your child is eligible for free school meals, they are also entitled to receive milk at school at no extra cost. If your child would like to receive milk from September and is eligible for free school meals, please email office@stocksbridgejunior.chorustrust.org.

Medication Collection

If your child has any medication stored at school, please collect this from the school office before we break up for the summer holidays.

Any medication not collected by this date will be safely disposed of at the local pharmacy. In September, we will need to start fresh, so if your child requires medication to be kept in school, a new Administering Medicines form and updated care plan will be required for the new academic year.

Dinner Money Balances

With only one week to go until the summer break, we kindly ask parents to check their child's dinner money balance on Arbor. This is especially important for our Year 6 families, as any outstanding debt will need to be cleared, and any remaining credit used up before your child leaves.

GREAT BRITISH SUMMER SAVINGS SCHEME

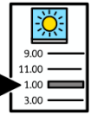
From 25 June to 1 September 2026, the Government is temporarily cutting VAT from 20% to 5% on children's meals in restaurants, children and family tickets to cinemas, theatres, concerts and exhibitions, and admission to a wide range of attractions. Combined with free bus travel during August for children aged 5 to 15 in England, families and young people will be able to enjoy experiences that make summer special,

including visits to the kinds of cultural and educational attractions that enrich children's lives outside the classroom.

Dear Parents and Carers,

The School Age Immunisation Team will be visiting schools from September 2026 to give the **Seasonal Flu Vaccine** to children. **A single dose of the flu nasal spray will mean your child is less likely to become ill if they come into contact with the flu virus.**

	1. Nasal spray- This is the most effective way to protect your child from flu. (Please note: it contains pork gelatine.)
