

The Triple P - Positive Parenting Programme

Group Triple P

What is Fear-Less Triple P?

A cognitive behavioural therapy program that supports parents to help children aged **6-16** years with moderate to severe anxiety, recognise and cope effectively with their anxieties and fears.

Sessions

Fear-Less Triple P consists of 6, 2-hour sessions spread over 6 consecutive weeks.

Fear-Less Triple P helps:

- To give parents a better understanding of what anxiety is.
- How to encourage and promote emotional resilience.
- To help parents become the best role models they can be for children learning to manage their anxiety and promote realistic thinking.
- Using exposure to help to overcome avoidance.
- Learn about effective and less effective ways of responding to your children's anxiety.
- Constructive problem solving and how to maintain progress.
